

The Royal British Legion Poppy Appeal 2018



Sponsor a Lamp Post Poppy

11th November 2018 marks the 100th Anniversary of the end of World War 1 from which many men and boys, including a significant number from Waterfoot and Cowpe, did not return. We want to give the people of Waterfoot and Cowpe a wonderful opportunity to honour all those who have fallen in wars since 1914, not forgetting the animals who didn't return from those wars.

Residents, businesses and organisations of Waterfoot and Cowpe are being asked to support a tribute to the fallen by sponsoring a giant poppy, which will be placed on lamp posts along Bacup Road, Burnley Road East and Cowpe Road. The poppies will mark the way to Trickett's Memorial Garden and to the War Memorial in Cowpe.

Poppies can be sponsored by private individuals, businesses and organisations for a minimum donation of £10 per poppy (you can sponsor more than one poppy if you wish). Each poppy will include the sponsor's name eg, "Sponsored by" or "Dedicated to" or "In Memory of" or you can leave it blank.

Volunteers will place the poppies on lamp posts during the week commencing 27th October 2018 and they will be removed during the week commencing 19th November 2018.
